The steps in this structured process include individual reflection as well as group discussion. In this gospel of the moment, we will focus on questions that when viewed through the eyes of faith can call forth greater meaning in our lives and lead us to engage in acts of transformation. Although this workshop can stand alone, it is intended as an opening session, to launch an ongoing sequence of gatherings that will focus on in depth conversations and theological reflection on the themes generated from the opening event.

He has led numerous workshops, conferences, and retreats in the United States and abroad, focused on the dynamic integration of theology, social science, depth psychology, popular education, community organization, and evolutionary philosophy.
